Re: Application for Exemption from Compliance with Clauses 107, 113, 114 and 118 of the OHS Regulation 2001


Please find enclosed a copy of Exemption Order No.017/10 issued under the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001.

**OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATION 2001
(Clause 347)**

Exemption Order No. 017/10

I, Peter Dunphy, Director, Specialist Services Group, Work Health and Safety Division of the WorkCover Authority of New South Wales, pursuant to Clause 347 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001* make the following Order.

**Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001
Exemption Order No. 017/10**

1. Name of Order

This Order is the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001 Exemption Order No. 017/10*.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on 19 January 2011, and has effect for a period of five years from that date.

3. Definitions

Code of practice, means the *AMBSC, CODE PART 4, DUPLEX STEEL BOILERS*.

AALS means Australian Association of Live Steamers Limited (ABN 81 107 882 404)

4. Exemption

Current members of the AALS are exempted from compliance with clauses:

- 107 - Application for registration of plant design,
- 113 - Application for registration of item of plant,
- 114 - Additional requirements for application to register amusement devices,
- 118 - Renewal of registration,

of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001, for items described in Schedule 1, and subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2.

Schedule 1

This Order applies to the registration of miniature duplex steel boilers built to Code of practice operated by the members of model railway societies, clubs or associations which are current members of the AALS.

Schedule 2

1. Design, manufacture and inspections are conducted in accordance with the current Code of practice.
2. Inspection and testing must be conducted by inspectors who have the minimum level of competency prescribed in the Code of practice.
3. Level of inspection and testing must meet the minimum criteria prescribed in the Code of practice.
4. Future revisions of the Codes of practice must offer at least the same or higher level of safety that was offered by the Code of practice.
5. The operators of boilers must have been trained and are competent to operate them safely.
6. Every society, club or association that owns devices to which this Order applies shall display a list detailing all boilers subject to the Order, with a copy of the Order, in a register kept for that purpose and available for inspection by WorkCover NSW officers on demand.
7. The Australian Association of Live Steamers Limited must annually provide a list of new members and people who have ceased to be members, who are subject to this exemption, to the WorkCover NSW quoting reference number 2010/014453.
