



THE TULLAMARINE TROPHY

The trophy is to be known as “The Tullamarine Trophy”.

The trophy is awarded in the spirit of promoting the building of high standard models of steam driven road vehicles in Australia.

1. The trophy is to be decided by a panel of judges appointed by the Tullamarine Live Steam Society, the Australian Association of Live Steamers and the Host Society.
2. Any model steam driven road vehicle built by the Owner and operating at the Convention will be eligible.
3. The trophy need not be awarded if, in the opinion of the judging panel, that a satisfactory standard of models has not been reached.
4. The judging panel will judge the models on the following criteria:
 - (a) Fidelity to prototype or originality of design. 30 points
 - (b) Workmanship 30 points
 - (c) Performance 30 points
 - (d) Presentation 10 points

The points shown above are the maximum for each category.

In the event of a tied vote the judges will award a further score out of 10 to decide the winner.

5. Once a particular model has been awarded the trophy, it shall thereafter be ineligible.
6. The winner will receive a trophy which they may keep. The Society of which the winner is a member shall be custodian of the perpetual trophy, and be responsible for its safe keeping and availability for presentation at the next Convention. If the winner is not a member of a Society or the trophy is not awarded the Tullamarine Live Steam Society shall hold the trophy.
7. A suitable inscription is to be placed on the trophies for each winner, stating winner's name, vehicle description, the winner's Society and the year. The cost of this inscription will be borne by the Tullamarine Live Steam Society upon presentation of an account from the winner's Society who are asked to arrange for the engraving of the inscriptions.
8. The trophy shall become the property of the Australian Association of Live Steamers with the following covenants:
 - (i) The trophy is only to be used for the award as described herein.
 - (ii) The rules are not to be changed without the approval of the Tullamarine Live Steam Society.
 - (iii) Should the award lapse or the Australian Association of Live Steamers disband the trophy shall become the property of the Tullamarine Live Steam Society.
