

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All registered attendees to present tickets to collect their wrist bands for entry.

Fees **do** include morning and afternoon tea and access to tea and coffee during the event from the clubhouse.

Fees do **not** include meals for breakfast, lunch or dinner.

Fees do **not** include accommodation costs at the club site (Book these separately using the Accommodation Registration Form)

Attendees are responsible for the security of any of their equipment while in the grounds

All attendees entering the site must sign on in the Sign on Book.

Operational Terms and Conditions.

1. The railway operation will be under the direction of LMLSLS and all equipment running on the track will only be permitted at the discretion of the Duty Officer or his / her assistants.
2. Train lengths will be limited to a maximum of 10 meters overall between 8.00am and 5.00pm to allow access for all attendees, unless otherwise announced by the Duty Officer. Train lengths are unlimited outside this timeframe and there is no curfew (no horns or whistles between 8.00pm and 8.00am).
3. There will be a limited supply of black coal or Bacchus Marsh char available however it is suggested that you bring your own fuel so suit your loco. No oil or boiler treatment will be supplied however light up kindling will be available.
4. All steam models will require a current boiler certificate which will be checked and recorded.
5. Track speed is 12kph for 7 1/4" gauge and 8kph for 5" gauge.
6. Please adhere to speed limits posted
7. Please note that 7 1/4" gauge is to give way to 5" gauge.
8. Radio Controlled locomotives- Driver must be on further than the first riding carriage away from the locomotive.
9. Night running must have lights- White for front and Red for rear.
10. No horns or whistles after 10.00pm.
11. No Public Running during the event.
12. Track Facilities - maximum allowable dimensions
 - i) 3 1/2" + 5" Unloader 500mm (19 1/2") Wide - 2950mm
 - ii) (9'8") Long - for 3 1/2" or 5" gauge
 - iii) 5" + 7 1/4" Unloader 710mm (28") Wide - 4450mm
 - iv) (14'7") Long - for 7 1/4" only.
13. Maximum Radius - 5" gauge is 13.7M (45'), 7 1/4" gauge is 18M (60')
14. All incidents to be reported to the Duty Officer.
